

180 Claims In Land Case

HEDERA - TULKARM DISPUTE (From Our Correspondent)

Haiifa, Wednesday.— No less than 180 Arabs are alleged to be interested in a land case involving the purchase by Hedera Jews of a 5000 dunam tract in the Ghor el Vasa.

The case had come up before the Land Settlement Officer, Mr. Lowick, in June, when he decided that the area in question was in the Tulkarm, and not the Hedera district. To-day the appeal against his decision was to have been heard in the District Court, composed of Mr. de Freitas and Aziz Eff. Daoudi.

The Court spent several hours in trying to ascertain if all the Arabs said to have a claim had been served notice of the appeal. The case was adjourned until November 17 on the ground that they were not all in court.

Each side is represented by four advocates.
